<b>Level of Study</b>	<b>Mixed</b> – Suitable for all from beginners to advanced
<b>No. of weeks</b>	This course will enrol on a termly basis for a maximum of 10/20 or 30 weeks.
<b>Hours per week</b>	2 hours per week
<b>Course Fees</b>	£54 for 10 weeks (You may be entitled to either a free course or support with your fees and other costs. Please ask at your centre) Reduced fee: £42 for WMDC residents who are over 60 and retired.
<b>Additional costs</b>	The tutor provides information on a range of resources that can be purchased as and when required. Learners bring their own materials each week to create a flower design. This will cost a minimum of £5 per week.
<b>Qualification aim</b>	Non-accredited
<b>Who is it for?</b>	Anyone wishing to develop skills in a wide range of flower arranging styles and techniques.
<b>Course aims</b>	To use a wide range of flower arranging techniques and processes through the development of varied designs both traditional and contemporary.
<b>Course content</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Practical work creating a wide range of floral designs</li> <li>• Use of appropriate materials and equipment to create designs</li> <li>• Tutor demonstrations to introduce new techniques and designs</li> </ul>
<b>Other information related to the course</b>	Course resources and teaching methods are varied in order to be inclusive. The tutor will introduce each technique through demonstrations, individual and group tuition. Regular feedback is given to all learners and progress is recorded using an Individual Learning Plan.
<b>What do I need to bring?</b>	New learners or those with little experience instructions will be given about the suitability of materials and what to bring for each session. A sharp pair of scissors and/or secateurs and plastic covering for the table will be useful together with a notebook and pen.
<b>Where next?</b>	During your course, your tutor will discuss appropriate progression opportunities available to you.
