<b>Who is it for?</b>	Anyone who wishes to understand and use their digital camera with much greater control.	
<b>Course aims</b>	Demystify the available options in the camera menus and controls. To become more aware of basic photographic considerations, helping to create better photographs.	
<b>Course content</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Overview of digital terminology e.g. Pixels – What are they?</li><li>• Types of digital camera – how to choose a camera, cost implications, suitability of the camera for a given purpose</li><li>• Image capture – Explore the cameras exposure modes, how the camera captures an image – explained in a non-technical way</li><li>• Camera options that affect the image quality</li><li>• Importance of correct White balance selection</li><li>• Selection of appropriate focussing modes</li><li>• Image transfer techniques – how to get your pictures out of the camera</li><li>• Printing your pictures – selecting the correct pixel resolution for inkjet prints or photographic prints using software</li></ul>	
<b>Other information related to the course</b>	Anyone attending the course should already have a digital camera.	
<b>What do I need to bring?</b>	Digital camera, camera instruction book/CD. Leads supplied with camera	
<b>Where next?</b>	Possible progression routes from this course are to attend a further series of classes on the use of image editing software. Obtain a basic level of understanding on how the software can help improve images.	
<b>How to enrol</b>	Fill in an enrolment form and return to the relevant centre with your payment or proof of benefit. Alternatively go to the centre to enrol in person.
