**Who is it for?** People who have completed our First Steps with Photoshop course, and who wish to learn more about how to edit, enhance, manipulate and store photographs using Photoshop.

You will have an elementary knowledge of digital imaging software. You may have completed our First Steps with Photoshop course. You may have gained your image editing skills informally by regularly using Photoshop or similar software.

**Course aims** Next Steps with Photoshop is designed to introduce you to some of the more advanced tools and techniques that can be used to edit and manipulate photographs and other images.

**Course content**

- Use text, drop shadows and layer styles
- Correct for exposure problems using "Adjustments/Adjustment Layers"
- Edit and retouch images using basic tools (e.g. paintbrush, aerosol, eraser, clone brush, paint bucket) and common selection tools (e.g. lasso, marquee, magic wand)
- Use layers, layer opacity and layer blending to create composite images that incorporate text and images
- Sharpen images using a number of techniques
- Create special effects using filters

**Other information related to the course**

Next Steps with Photoshop is a short course, so you need to make sure that you can attend every session.

**What do I need to bring?**

2GB memory stick, so that you can transfer images to your own PC for working on between classes, you want to bring.
