Who is it for?	For learners who want to consolidate the essential skills and knowledge of the language and/or have successfully completed Year 1 or similar introductory course.
Course aims	To consolidate the basics and expand the range of language understanding and knowledge through the introduction of additional topics and situations. You will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • develop your speaking, listening, reading and writing skills in a wider range of situations • apply your understanding of language use and function • consider aspects of culture in a wider range of situations
Course content	Topics may include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exchanging information about holidays • Following written instructions • Understanding menus • Finding out about a particular area • Responding to and sending invitations • Writing a brief biography
Other information related to the course	Course resources, teaching methods and learning activities are varied in order to be inclusive and provide opportunities to develop the four language skills: speaking, listening, reading and writing. Regular feedback is given to all learners and progress is recorded using an Individual Learning Plan.
What do I need to bring?	An A4 ring binder, paper and pen in order to organise your notes and handouts from the tutor.
Where next?	Successful completion of a year 2 will give you the skills you need to progress to Year 3.
